I wonder whether you would be kind enough to help me in the following matter.

As I have now played all the Maconchy concertos on the 3rd Programme I would like to suggest some modern pieces for piano solo such as the Epitaph on the name of Beig by Vladimir Vogel, Capriccio and Preludes by Giacinto Celzi (the Vegh Quartet nearly played his quartet a short time ago but something pre-

vented them coming to this country at the last minute I think!) Then there are the Messiaen Preludes, Bartók Etudes, Alban Beig Sonata and several pieces by Swiss composers such as the Toccata by Höschinger, Sonata, Burkhardt Suite by Stämpfli, Preludes of d'Alessandro etc.

All these I have played and broadcasted in Switzerland. Can you tell me who I should suggest them to and which have to be submitted to a reading panel. I am afraid I am rather in the dark about the usual proceedings and would be very grateful for your advice on the matter.
